



PAUNSAUGUNT ATV TRAILS

A GUIDE TO THE TROPIC RESERVOIR AREA & EAST FORK OF THE SEVIER RIVER

The Paunsaugunt Plateau has some of the most scenic ATV routes available. The U.S. Forest Service has designated several loops where riders can enjoy the area with all its scenic beauty. Bryce Canyon is carved out of the eastern edge of the Paunsaugunt Plateau. ATVs, OHVs and UTVs are not permitted in Bryce Canyon National Park, but riders can enjoy similar scenery on the Paunsaugunt. Bryce Canyon-like scenery wraps around the plateau to the south and west, where most of the ATV routes are located.

Watch for DEER, ELK and ANTELOPE as they are found abundantly on the Paunsaugunt. Bears and mountain lions also live in the area but are rarely seen. Many other birds and animals also make this their home.

Depending on the winter snow, routes are opened when they are accessible without damaging roads. Please respect the rules, stay on designated ATV routes, and have fun.
